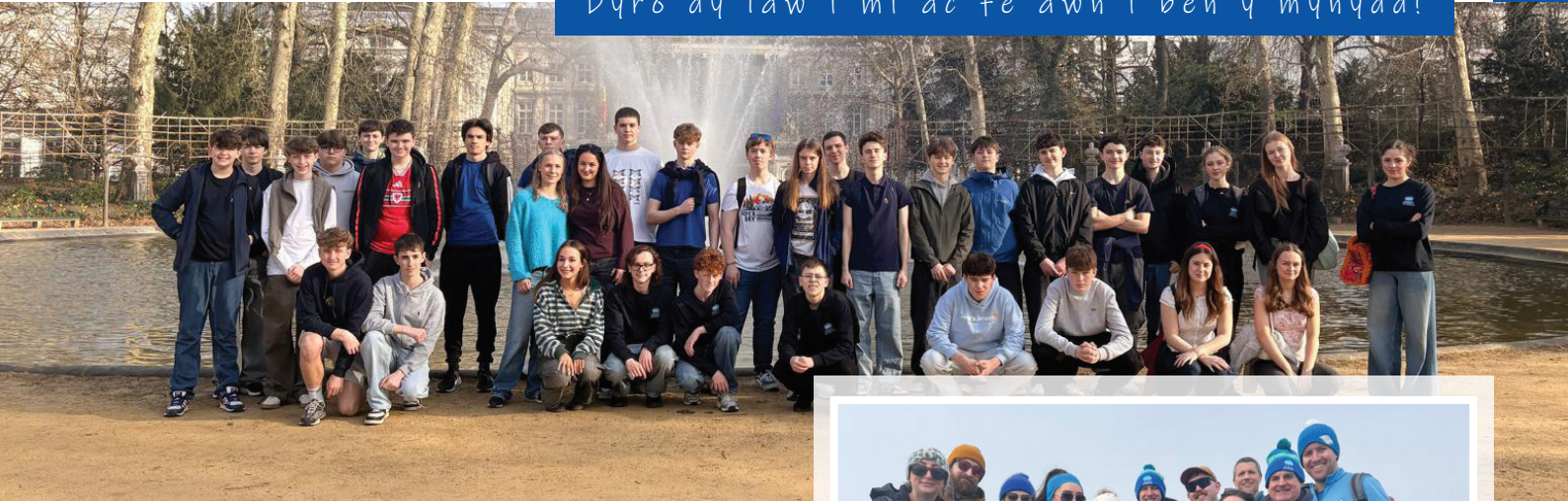

## Staff 3 Peaks Challenge

2025 is a very special year in the history of our school as we are celebrating a significant milestone – our 25th anniversary. Since opening our doors in the year 2000 with only 120 pupils and 10 members of staff, we have grown enormously. Twenty five years later, we now have 1,400 pupils and 150 staff members serving Welsh medium education in the Vale of Glamorgan.

To mark this important milestone, we have organised a full programme of activities and celebrations. On the weekend of the 6th of March, 25 members of staff completed the Three Peaks Challenge by climbing Snowdon, Cadair Idris and Pen y Fan - quite an achievement and a significant physical challenge! The Welsh Department enjoyed a successful season of public speaking competitions, with pupils from various year groups representing the school. Year 9 were first to compete in the Seren Network debating competition, taking part in a challenging discussion and securing an impressive second place thanks to the strong performances of Emlyn Evans, Betsan Black, Iwan Lucas and Liza Braddon.

The Sixth Form then took part in the Rotary South Wales Public Speaking competition, reaching the final at Yr Egin, Carmarthen. Their topic, centred on the Welsh Government's 2050 language target, sparked lively debate, and the team finished third overall. Individual success followed, with Elan Roberts placing third in the Best Chairperson category and Talar Rhys-Dillon winning Best Opposing Speaker.

In addition, author Rolant Tomos delivered engaging creative writing workshops, where Year 8 and 9 pupils developed characters and crisis scenarios in preparation for the Radio Cymru writing competition.

They went on to represent the school in the Oxford Schools' competition. And finally, we would like to give special praise to Gruffydd Bennet and Osian Pugh for being chosen to represent the school in the ESU Performing Shakespeare Competition.
